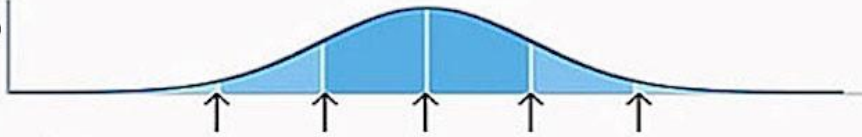

### Clean Condition, Definition

WheelchairVanAppraisals Defines Clean Condition as Follows:

- i) The vehicle is without moderate or severe accident, or odometer discrepancy or flood damage in its history. Vehicles 9 years old and newer are without any accident.
- ii) The vehicle has no indication of repairs needed for the conversion or the chassis
- iii) Gaskets and seals are 100% efficient in containing fluids
- iv) The vehicle has been driven at least 800 miles in the past year
- v) Tires and Brakes of the vehicle have at least 70% of "use life" remaining.
- vi) Belts are checked and changed according to manufacturers recommendations. If applicable, this includes the timing belt.
- vii) Fluids have been changed in a timely manner according to the guidelines of the manufacturer and the type of fluid used. This includes
- viii) The vehicle looks very good, including interior flooring, interior trim, exterior skirts, body and paint
- ix) The underside of the vehicle has been inspected for rust. Rust is not an issue that currently effects or gives cause of future concern of rust permeation. In particular the strength and integrity of the floor, the vehicle frame, the suspension, the exhaust system, the fuel or brake systems, or the sliding door tracks of the vehicle are not in question.
- x) The vehicle has had relatively few owners. Since, on average, accessible vehicles have more owners than unconverted vehicles, Wheelchair Van Appraisals suggests a vehicle can still be considered clean with multiple owners provided it does not show more than one owner average per 5 years. Exceptions to 5 years can be taken if there is documentation of regular maintenance.
